The beavers have been removed and Martin has been in communication with the DNR in regard to the removal of the beaver dams along the portion of the Baraboo River which lies within the Village.

*Discussion on what to do with the park buildings that were damaged in the 2018 floods. No action will be taken at this time. Before any work can be done on the buildings, fill needs to be brought in and a retaining wall needs to be added. The village is not ready to start this project at this time.
