PUBLIC NOTICE

In response to the 2018 flood event and Wisconsin DNR requirements, improvements to Village's municipal water system are being proposed. Improvements include demolition of existing Wellhouse #2 and adjacent surrounding foundation ruins, filling the site and grading for the construction of a new Wellhouse #2 with new pumping equipment and standby generator. Proposed system improvements also include insulation and siding at existing Wellhouse #4 and replacement of the existing pumping and electrical equipment. A modern supervisory control and data acquisition system (SCADA) will be installed to provide enhanced control and integration of the well and storage facilities. Per Administrative Code, the Wisconsin Public Service Commission (PSC) must grant construction authorization for the project to proceed and has authority to regulate consumer rates for water service. PSC staff estimates a 73% water rate increase due to the proposed project. The rate increase will raise the average monthly water bill for a residential customer that uses 3,000 gallons per month from approximately \$29 per month to \$51 per month (not including the public fire protection charge). PSC staff also estimates the tax levy for municipal fire protection will rise approximately 73% from the current \$55,291 per year to approximately \$96,000 per year.
